

Capital City Condors - Parent Code of Conduct 2023-2024

The Capital City Condors hockey club ("Condors") is committed to ensuring that each and every player has fun, feels a part of the team, learns skating and hockey skills, and enjoys a safe and positive hockey experience!

The game of hockey is well recognized for its respect of everyone involved, and this is demonstrated by our attitudes and our language both on and off the ice. Condors players need to be careful both in how they speak to people and how they treat people. Condors Coaches will call players out on inappropriate conduct and attitude both on and off the ice, if required, and disciplinary action may be taken as well if deemed appropriate by the Condors Disciplinary Committee whose responsibility it is to review each and every report involving behavioural incidents.

As such, the Condors expect that both players and parents (or guardians) will treat each other and the coaches/volunteers with respect and in a manner that portrays good sportsmanship, a love of the game, and the pleasure of being a team member!

PARENT/GUARDIAN: Practices, Games and Tournaments

- I will attend and remain inside the rink/venue during all practices, games, and tournaments whether "at home" or "away" with my player(s) and will remain responsible for their and my behaviour at all times. If this is not possible, I will select a guardian to attend in my place and will notify the Condors GM via email before-hand.
- I will treat other parents and coaches (of Condors teams and any other teams we interact with) with respect and will ask questions or provide feedback using the appropriate channels.
- I will cheer on all our amazing athletes during practices and games.
- I will encourage my player to share, have fun, and be a terrific teammate to the best of their ability.
- I will be engaged and proactive in helping my player(s) play safely and will work together with the coaches to come up with strategies and solutions for any issues that may arise.
- If I experience or witness abuse or mistreatment in any form, I will tell the Director of Coaching, the Head Coach or a member of the Condors Board of Directors right away.

PARENT/GUARDIAN: Unacceptable Behaviours

• I will not make rude or inappropriate physical, verbal, or sexual comments or gestures while

involved in the Condors hockey program whether at a practice, game, tournament, or social event.

- I will not make rude or inappropriate, aggressive or sexual comments to any other member of the Condors organization on social media or anywhere else online.
- I will not fight in any way at any Condors function because I understand that fighting will lead to me being suspended from playing and possibly even removed from the team!
- I will not become drunk or use illegal drugs while involved in any and all Condors events and activities.
- I will not take any photos or videos in any of the dressing rooms at any time. I will not use inappropriate language (swearing or calling others bad names) or display any type of aggressive behaviour at any Condors sanctioned event or with any other member of the Condors organization whether in-person or online.

Further, I understand that if I do not follow the Capital City Condors Code of Conduct, the Condors Disciplinary Committee or the Board of Directors may implement consequences which could include suspension from accompanying my player to any or all practices, games, tournaments or social events. In such a case it would be my responsibility to find another responsible adult to accompany my player(s) to Condors sanctioned activities.

Thank-you for your cooperation in helping us to ensure that Condors Hockey is a safe and fun environment for all where life-long friendships and memories are made!

Note: some adult players may be exempt from being accompanied by their parent/guardian at certain Condors events or activities on a "case by case" basis. Such players must adhere and behave in a manner compatible with the terms of this Code of Conduct.
